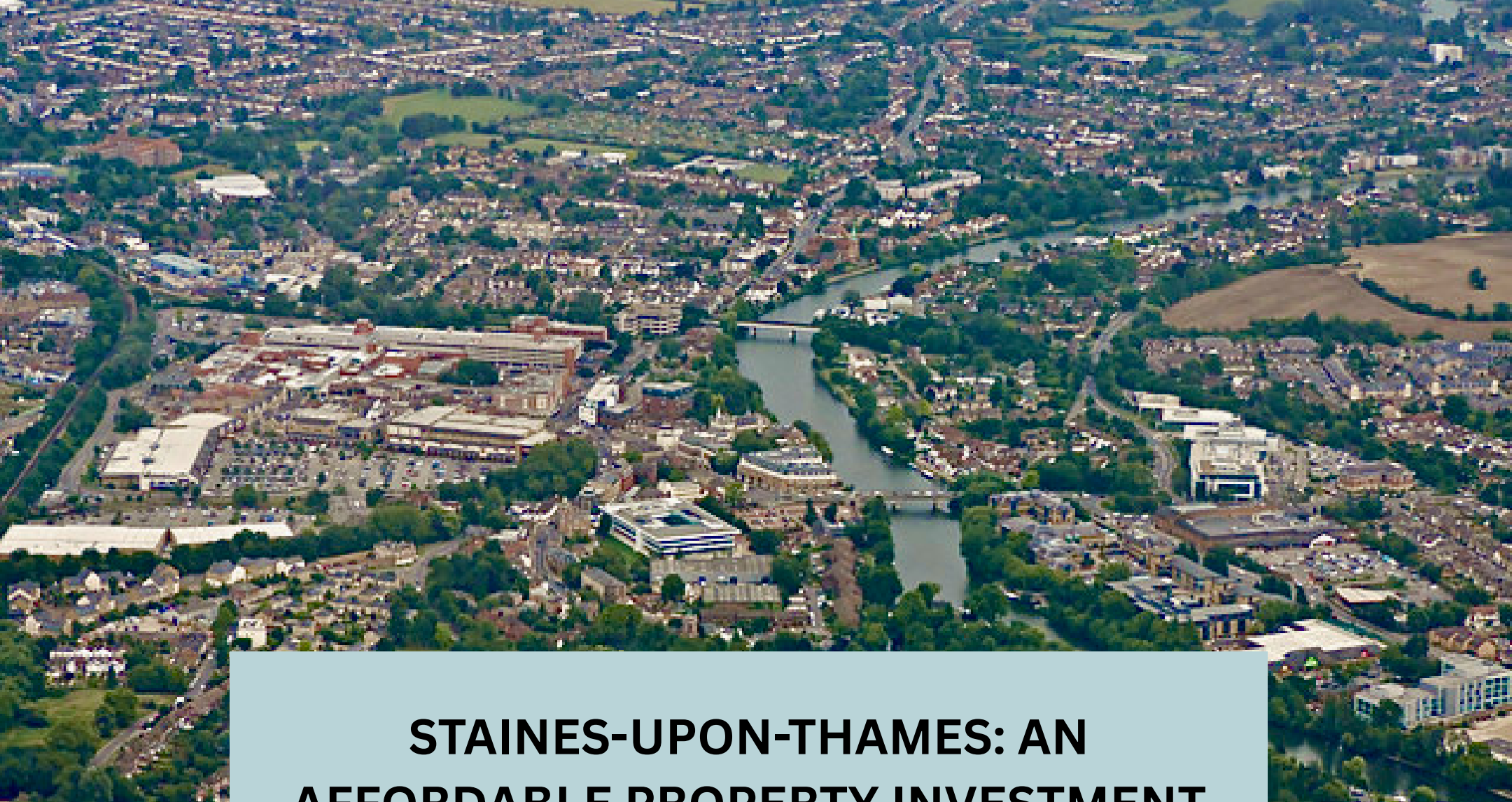

For students pursuing further education, several top institutions are within 10 miles of Staines:

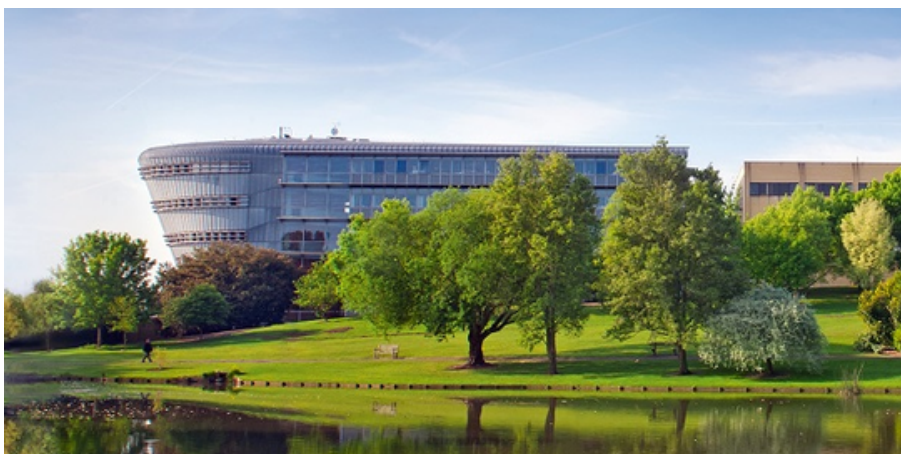
Royal Holloway, University of London (Egham) – A prestigious research university and part of the University of London, known for humanities, sciences, and business.

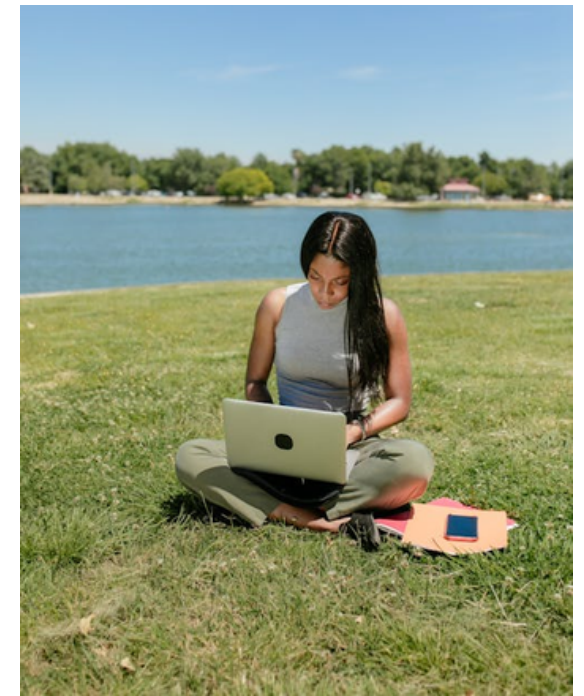
